Scriptural Viewpoints of Christ's Atoning Death

**1) It Was Part of God's Eternal Purpose**  
1 Peter 1:17-21 (Refer to Session #2)

**2) It was a Fulfillment of OT Prophecy**  
Luke 24:44-48

**3) It was the chief purpose of the Incarnation.**  
Hebrews 2:9-14

**4) It's a major theme of the Gospel**  
Acts 2:22-24, 1 Cor 15:1-4

**5) It is prominent in New Testament writings.**

His last 3 days occupies about 1/5 of the Gospels. His death is mentioned about 175 times in the NT (see the final chapters of the Gospels & all throughout the Epistles (Letters))

**6) His Death was a Voluntary Act.**  
John 10:17-18, Matthew 26:39, 52-54

**7) His Death was Essential to Salvation's Plan.**  
John 3:14-18

**8) It Brought about Redemption**  
Titus 2:14

**9) He was a Ransom for us.**  
= price paid for canceling a debt  
**Mark 10:45**  
John 19:30 – "It is finished" – paid in full

**10) His Death was Designed to be a Substitute for us.**  
= takes the place of another, delegate, representative  
**Romans 5:5-8**

**11) His blood & death justify us.**  
(excuse, acquit, exonerate) by faith  
**Romans 5:9**

**12) It Reconciled us to the Father.**  
 The restoration to divine favor (atonement)  
**Romans 5:10-11 & Colossians 1:21-23**

**13) His Death satisfied the Father's Holy Requirements**  
 Luke 24:46 "Father, into your hands I commit My spirit."  
 John 19:30 "It is finished"  
**1 John 2:2, 4:10**  
 (Propitiation, it pleased the Father)  
**Ephesians 5:2, Isaiah 53:4,6,10** 7

**14) It was a Manifestation of Divine Love.**  
 1 John 3:16, 1 John 4:9-10

**15) It was the Conquest of satan's kingdom, death, hell and the grave.**  
 Colossians 2:13-15, Hebrews 2:14-16  
 Revelation 1:18 8

**16) It activated the New Covenant.**  
 Matthew 26:28 & Hebrews 9:11-17

**17) His blood remits, forgives our sins.**  
 Matthew 26:28 – "for the remission of sins"  
 Colossians 1:13-14

**18) His Death was Complete & Final.**  
 Hebrews 9:12, 23-28 & 10:11-18 9

**19) His Death was a point of obedience to the Father.**  
 Philippians 2:8

**20) In His Death, He became a curse for us & opened the pathway to blessing.**  
 Galatians 3:13

**1 Corinthians 5:7-8**

**22) His Death opened direct access to the Father.**  
 Intimacy for everyone who desires  
**Matthew 27:50-51 & Hebrews 10:19-22**
