### **The Gospel of Matthew**

**Author:** The Apostle Matthew, former Jewish tax collector turned disciple. His conversion is found in Matthew 9:9. Also known as Levi.

**Theme:** Portrays Jesus as the King of Kings, the Messiah, the Son of David, the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecy, the Son of God, the Son of Man

#### **Facts**

The word "fulfilled" occurs 15 times, Matthew quotes several Old Testament passages, traces Jesus' genealogy back to Abraham, Jesus teaches the constitution of His Kingdom in Chapters 5-7 (Sermon on the Mount), Matthew 13 contains several of the parables of Jesus, refers to Jesus as the "Son of Man" 30 times

### **The Gospel of Luke**

**Author:** Luke, the physician, a close companion of Paul. Also authored the Book of Acts.

**Theme:** Portrays Jesus as the Perfect Man, the Savior of the World, the Messiah, the Son of Man

#### **Facts**

The Gospel According to Luke is Part 1 of 2: The Book of Acts is part 2, traces Jesus' genealogy back to Adam (the first man), focuses on the humanity of Jesus more than any other Gospel, Jesus is frequently seen in prayer, refers to Jesus as the "Son of Man" 26 times, refers to Jesus as "Lord" 18 times (50 times in Acts)

### **The Gospel of Mark**

**Author:** John Mark, a spiritual son of Peter and fellow minister of Paul and Barnabas

**Theme:** Portrays Jesus as the Servant of God, the Son of God, the Messiah

#### **Facts**

The shortest of the 4 Gospels, consistently emphasizes the authority & power of Jesus, Jesus calls Himself the "Son of Man" 14 times, records more miracles than any other Gospel, emphasizes the call to discipleship and the cost of discipleship, ends with a declaration of the authority & power given to followers of Jesus

### **The Gospel of John**

**Author:** The Apostle John, known as the "beloved disciple", part of Jesus' inner circle

**Theme:** Portrays Jesus as the Son of God, the Messiah, the God-Man. Theme stated in John 20:31.

#### **Facts**

Jesus is shown as the Creator and the Eternal God who has come to earth in the flesh, attributes several Divine titles to Jesus, emphasizes the Deity of Jesus, a large portion of this Book reveals the private teachings Jesus gave to His disciples, contains the High Priestly Prayer of Jesus in chapter 17
