### AGES

1. INFANTS (bed babies & crawlers)
2. WALKERS to 24 MONTHS
3. 2 year olds
4. 3 year olds

### LOCATION

Nurseries are located down the hallway on the right as you come in the foyer facing the sanctuary. Look for the signs.

### FACILITIES

Our Nurseries are equipped with:

- Friendly, Caring Workers
- Age appropriate music, toys & books
- Closed circuit TV of the sanctuary
- Changing tables. Changing tables are also located in the men & women's restroom and nursery area restroom.
- Cribs for infants
- Glass window on doors to check on your child without disturbing them.

### OUR GOALS

## SAFETY FIRST

### REGISTRATION FORM

Parents and guardians are required to register each child at check-in desk located in nursery area. This registration will help us get to know you and your child and inform us of any special needs he/she might have. All registration sheets will be kept on file in the nursery area.

### IDENTIFICATION CARD

An Identification Card will be provided when you sign-in. Each card contains a number which will help us identify your child and their belongings. This card must be presented when you sign-out. This prevents an unauthorized person from leaving the nursery with your child.

*All Nursery Workers have filled out an application and have given their permission for the Church to run a background check.*

## BASIC GUIDELINES

1. Register at check-in desk.
2. Obtain I.D. Card for each child.
3. Present I.D. Card when picking up child. Only adults with an I.D. Card will be permitted to remove child from nursery.
4. Please Pick up your child immediately after service.
5. Sick children should not be brought to nursery. This includes children with fever, vomiting, diarrhea, questionable skin or eye conditions or any other contagious illness.
6. Bring extra diapers & pull-ups. All diaper bags and belongings should be labeled.
7. Animal crackers and water are provided for snacks.
8. Please bring labeled bottles and labeled spill proof cups.
9. "Time-outs" are the only form of discipline in nursery. Unruly children will be sent to parents/guardians. Biting, hitting, kicking, etc. cannot be tolerated.
10. Parents and older siblings should not be in nursery unless it is an emergency or they are workers. Coming in and out of nursery keeps children unsettled. A glass window on the door is there for you to check on your child.
11. Nursery workers are not permitted to give medication.
